THE WHISKY BAR AT ST PANCRAS GRAND

The water of life, uisge beatha, is the spirit of the Celts and its heritage dates back more than 600 years. From Ireland to Scotland and the world over, whisky is a most diverse, complex and intriguing sprit.

The term malt whisky indicates the raw material: barley malt (not grain); infused with water, fermented with yeast and distilled in a pot.

The term Scotch means that the whisky was distilled and matured in the country whose name it bears.

BLENDED AND DELUXE

A blended Scotch is the product of many distilleries, grains, ages and regions brought together by the art of the alchemist, the master blender. The greatest names in whisky all have their own styles which remain secret and consistent.

A blended scotch whiskey commonly contains about 40% malt; the odd one contains more than 60%. The cheaper blends contain much less.

Blends represent 90% of world whisky sales and have built the reputation of Scotch whisky around the globe.

GRAIN

Single grain is actually multi grain as it draws its production from several cereals. They are rare and distinct and known for their purity and light body.

They are distilled in a patent still to a high strength and matured for a minimum of three years in oak casks

VATTED

Some single malts are labelled as "pure malts". However, this term is also often used to indicate a vatting together of malt whiskies, made in several distilleries. This type of whisky is technically known as vatted malt. They contain only malt whisky with no grain whisky included in the blend.

SINGLE MALT

Single malt whisky represents the very heartbeat of Scotch whisky. With around 90 distilleries producing a multitude of styles, flavours, strengths and ages there exists a fascinating and rich palate from which the great names of the whisky trade have always drawn their blends and built their reputations. However, the very individuality of these distilleries has created huge interest with connoisseurs and enthusiasts the world over.

A single malt must be produced at one single distillery drawn from local water, 100% malted barley and distilled at least twice in a copper pot still. Matured for a minimum of 3 years in sherry, bourbon or other casks, bottled usually stating a minimum age on the label and signifying the region of origin.

LOWLAND

The Lowlands tend to produce whiskies in which the softness of the malt itself is more evident, untempered by the Highlands' peatiness or coastal brine and seaweed.

HIGHLAND

This is a bigger region and embraces wide variations. The far north of the Highlands has several whiskies with a notably heathery, spicy character, probably deriving from the local soil and the coastal location.

The more sheltered East Highlands and Midlands of Scotland have a number of fruity whiskies.

The western part of the Highlands at least on the mainland, have a rounded, firm, dry character, with some peatiness.

The speyside single malts are noted in general for their elegance and complexity as well as for their refined smokiness.

ISLANDS

The exposed position of the various islands off the western coast of Scotland makes these whiskies the boldest malts of all.

Islay is the greatest of the whisky islands, much of it deep with peat, lashed by the wind, rain and sea in the Inner Hebrides. Its single malts are noted for their seaweedy, iodine like phenolic character. A dash of Islay malt gives the unmistakable tang of Scotland to many blended whiskies.

IRISH WHISKEY

Irish whiskey is regarded as being the oldest in the world with evidence of production as early as the 12th Century and it is believed Celtic monks were making a sort of whiskey in the 6th Century for medicinal purposes. As with Scotch malted barley is the only cereal allowed. Most Irish whiskey is triple distilled which naturally gives a lighter fine spirit. Very rarely does smoke play a part meaning the whiskies are clean and light. The whiskey is aged in old sherry and bourbon casks for a minimum of three years.

AMERICAN BOURBON WHISKEY

The name bourbon originated from pioneers who named the county after the French Royal family in 1785. Nearly all Bourbon is produced in Kentucky however it can be made anywhere in the USA and oddly enough no bourbon is actually produced in Bourbon County at the present time.

The typical cereals for Bourbon production is 70% corn with the remainder being made up of rye, wheat and malted barley. The mash is double distilled and placed in charred oak casks for aging for a minimum of two years.
